In his long experience in architectural practice, Liverpool graduate **Jim Eyre** (LLD 2009) has been involved in a diverse range of project types at all stages of the design and construction process. His roles include key conceptual design on projects ranging from the Gateshead Millennium Bridge and the Cooled Conservatories at Gardens by the Bay in Singapore, to the New Bodleian Library in Oxford. He has a particular interest in multi-disciplinary projects where architectural creativity and engineering principles can be combined.

Professor Stephanie Hemelryk Donald is a respected international scholar. She was educated in the UK and in Singapore. Her research covers film, the media, and children's experiences in the Asia-Pacific region, with a particular focus on visual culture.
